

What happens if I follow our rules?

Good behaviour

You will be helping yourself to learn

Gold behaviour

You will be demonstrating resilience, readiness, responsibility, reflectiveness, reciprocity

This is something to be very proud of!

The adults in school will tell you well done ✓

You may be rewarded with planet points ✓

You may be rewarded with stickers or a certificate ✓

You may be sent to another teacher or to Mrs Burns to share your good work and behaviour ✓

You may be rewarded with golden time ✓

What happens if someone doesn't follow our rules?

Low level disruption

This means not following the school rules or teacher instructions.

Discussion with family to see how we can make the behaviour better

Lose some of the playtime or lunchtime or walk with an adult during these times

Your parents may be told

Red = Time out in your classroom

2 warnings = Moving down the traffic lights

Verbal reminder

Serious behaviour

This means someone has been swearing, deliberately hurting another child, breaking/damaging property or fighting

Exclusion - this means behaviour has been very serious and you are not allowed to come to school for a day or maybe more.

Internal exclusion- this is usually with Mrs Burns and means you will not be with your class for the lesson

You will miss your lunchtime and playtime

Your parents will be told

A behaviour incident form will be completed by Mrs Burns

You will be sent to Mrs Burns
