



Safeguarding Children

Amington Heath Primary School and Nursery School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

- All adults in this school are responsible for the safety, wellbeing and pastoral support of pupils.
- We encourage children and adults to share concerns or issues and operate a robust approach to dealing with concerns.
- The school's Child Protection Policy is reviewed annually by the Full Board of Governors. The school has a statutory responsibility to discuss with Education and Children's Services (Social Services) any concerns that we might have about a child that may indicate physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse or neglect. There are two Designated Members of Staff for Child Protection at Amington Heath Primary School and Nursery.
- Amington Heath Primary School and Nursery interview process includes a question relating to the promotion of the welfare and safeguarding of children and young people and application for a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.
- All employees are checked on List 99 and are expected to complete an application for a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check :
